Christmas is just around the corner and the AWTC Club is now open for reservation for the special dates such

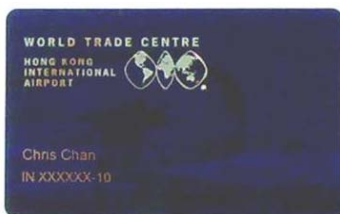
